

Established in 1950 at village SidhwanKhurd, 30 km away from Ludhiana in lush green rural background, aptly hailed as the 'Shantiniketan' of Punjab, Khalsa College for Women, SidhwanKhurd (Ludhiana) is a living testimony to the generosity of legendary donors Bhai Sahib BhaiNarain Singh and his wife Bibi Ram Kaur and later their daughter BibiHarparkash Kaur Padam Shree Awardee and daughter-in-law Bibi Attar Kaur. It is one of the five educational institutions run by Sri Guru HargobindUjagarHari Trust.

The Trust and the institution came into being due to the great personal loss suffered by the founder Bhai Sahib BhaiNarain Singh Ji and his wife Bibi Ram Kaur Ji when they lost their only son Kaka Ujjagar Singh in a mishap in 1908. Coming to terms with this loss and making the supreme effort of starting life afresh, they devoted themselves to the task of educating their daughter BibiHarparkash Kaur. This resulted in the establishment of a primary school in May 1909 with four students, after which there was no looking back. The philanthropic spirit of the founders saw the Trust develop from a fledgling one into a fully grown organization, which today prides itself of Five Educational Institutions holding aloft the lamp of knowledge by our Honorable Sri Guru HargobindUjjagarHari Trust and Mata Ram Kaur Charitable Hospital to cater to the medical needs of the poor and needy. The torch bearers who are carrying forward the old traditions and guiding us today to the right path are S. Birindar Singh Sidhu, IPS (President), S. Amarjeet Singh (Secretary), S. Pardeep Singh (Manager), S. Kirpal Singh Bhatthal (Member), S. Pritam Singh Johal (Member), S. Harmail Singh Sidhu (Member) and S. Devinder Singh Mann (Member).

Ever since its inception the college, has been playing a commendable role in providing quality education to women, especially, of rural areas. But for the thoughtful munificence of the founders, most of the girls coming from disadvantaged families in the area would have been deprived of the fruits of knowledge and suffered the ignominy of lack of higher education in the fast developing social scenario. Our College has maintained high standards in the field of discipline as well as academic, moral and physical development of the students. The college strives at its best to help dispel ignorance, spread knowledge and thereby propagate the lofty ideals of service and sacrifice. The college that made a humble start 70 years ago with only a few girl students, has been moving forward in its progress march to establish itself as one of the major Rural Educational Colleges for Women. A single faculty degree college to start with, the college today can, with justifiable validity, pride itself of being a Multi-faculty, Post-Graduate Rural College for Women in Punjab. Total 332 students on rolls, it now caters to all the four streams i.e. Humanities, Science, Commerce and Computer Science. Keeping in view the current scenario, we have M.A. (History, Punjabi, English and Political Science), M.Com, M.Sc. IT, PGDMC, PGDCA, B.A., BCA, B.Com., B.Sc., B.A./B.Sc. B.Ed. 4 Year Integrated courses and three add on Certificate, Diploma and Advance Diploma courses in Web Designing and Multimedia, Computer Based Accounting and Communicative English. A highly qualified and experienced staff under the seasoned guidance of the Principal and College Management is committed to the task of instilling in the students the love of

knowledge. The college has **36 faculty** members of whom **11 are Ph.Ds. 11 M.Phils.**. In addition, the college has a fairly strong contingent of **Non-teaching employees including 04 Office-staff**, **03 Laboratory Staff**, **19 other Non-teaching staff and support staff**.

The college is spread over **18.75 acres of land**. It has put up a physical structure in the shape of well-furnished and well ventilated lecture rooms, smart class rooms, computer labs with internet facility, computerized library, seminar hall, non-resident center, departmental rooms, examination hall, laboratories, auditorium, gymnasium, a huge hostel complex, bus shed, a fleet of 21 buses, power room, canteen and various playgrounds. Infrastructure in the form of equipment and apparatus such as projectors, slide projector and smart boards is also available. The college also provides the facility of Short Term Courses Quantitative Aptitude and Reasoning, Spoken English Classes, Computer Basics, Training of Indian Musical Instruments, Art and Craft Course, Recreational Sports.

The college also gives ample opportunity to its students to identify and explore their talents and areas of interest by giving them, the chance of becoming members of various clubs and committees like College Student Association (CSA), Commerce Society, Computer Science Cell, English Literary Forum, Social Sciences Forum, Punjabi SahitSabha, Road Safety and Environment Protection Cell, , Science Club, Legal Literacy Club, Photography Club, Youth Club, Library Committee, Bebe Ram Kaur Society, BibiHarprakash Kaur Society, Gurudwara Committee, Red Cross Society, Red Ribbon Club, NSS and NCC. The institution has constituted prevention of Women Harassment Cell, Anti-ragging Cell and Grievance Redressal Cell to provide a safe and secure performance.

The superstitions and misconceptions about menstruation were also dispelled by her. A health checkup camp was organized by her team in which BMI, hemoglobin and blood group were tested.
